About GATI

Greg Amerson Tennis International (GATI) offers an optimal high performance tennis program at multiple levels. Our focus is a disciplined and happy junior tennis player well positioned for success both on and off the court.

Philosophy

GATI uses focused instruction in a low pro to student ratio environment to develop technical skills complimented by physical endurance, mental maturity, and a strong presence on the court.

Registration

The GATI program performs an on-court assessment of each player before placing them in the appropriate academy group. Students are admitted as spaces become available in the program.

On-Going Assessments

GATI conducts on-going assessments to determine when students are ready to progress to the next academy level. We provide semi-annual student report via meetings with parents so that pros, parents, and students are aware of developmental progress at GATI.

Match Play

While academy drills and fitness training are essential to developing the well-rounded player, match play is an important component of practicing techniques and skills learning throughout the week. Coach monitored match play is offered through the three GATI academy programs.

GATI Academy Levels

Little Hitters

Little Hitters are developing hand-eye coordination, sportsmanship and a basic understanding of the game. Low pressure balls and a Quickstart format are fundamental components of instruction.

Academy I

Academy I students have developed a basic understanding of the game including game structure, basic movement, elementary stroke development, and serving. Students will be introduced to match play via Junior Team Tennis and Quickstart tournaments.

Academy II

Academy II students are proficient in all basic fundamentals of the game. Students are focused on performing at a competitive level in an effort to achieve a top 50 ranking. They are committed to mastering select components of the game, while strengthening physical capabilities.

Tour Academy

Tour Academy students are focused on year-round tournament play and achieving sectional, state, and national rankings. Students are typically home schooled, spending most of their afternoon and evening receiving specialized on-court instruction. They work with GATI pros to master all aspects of the game, while developing their own personal style.
